She received a Master of Divinity Degree from Phillips Theological Seminary in Tulsa, Oklahoma and a Batchelor of Science Degree in Mathematics from Jarvis Christian College in Hawkins, Texas. She also worked on her master's degree while attending Brite Divinity School at Texas Christian University in Fort Worth, Texas. During her seminary years Rev. Law served as Associate Pastor at First Christian Church in Carrollton, Texas. She is a proud member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. She enjoys a good book, traveling, lakes, oceans, and spending time with her friends and families. Rev. Law is passionate about building bridges in divided communities (doing the root work of co-creating anti-racist churches), radical hospitality around food and fun, and preaching the love of God made known in Jesus Christ that transforms the world.
